Teaching Responsibilities for SY 2024-2025:

- Classroom teacher: 4 classes with 2 preps
 - **8th Grade U.S. History** (M/W/Th) - 2 sections - using the Land of Hope (Young Readers) curriculum & participating in National History Day
 - **8th Grade American Literature/Composition** (M/W/Th) - 2 sections - using the Lost Tools of Writing curriculum, along with 3 novels, 2 short stories, and poetry
- Engage students in age-appropriate classical instruction
- Create a joyful, grace-filled classroom environment where students enjoy learning together
- Develop lesson plans for both on-campus and home days
- Set measurable objectives for students to move towards mastery
- Assess students both formally and informally and reflect results in their quarterly grade & periodic conduct reports
- Communicate consistently, truthfully, and graciously with students and parents
- Maintain a tidy and orderly classroom, taking care of curricula and equipment belonging to ACS and encouraging students to uphold the school-wide expectations regarding classroom behavior

On-Campus Time Requirements:

- Summer faculty training days will be held July 31-August 2, 2024. Informal meetings with teammates as needed in late July. Meetings with parents and students are the week of August 5, and teachers are required to be on campus at least two days during that week.
- On-campus instructional days for 5th-8th grades are Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays through the calendar school year (August 12, 2024-May 21, 2025). School hours are 8:25a-3:50p.
- Monthly faculty meetings are held one Friday of each month from 9a-12p.

Salary for the position is based on the number of sections taught and ranges between \$7,500-\$8,500 per section, depending upon relevant experience. Teachers are paid monthly from July through June.
