 November 15 - January 24 All checklist items, including testing, Shadow Student day, and family interviews must be complete by February 27. Decisions will be sent no later than March 6. 	 January 25 - April 11 All checklist items, including testing, Shadow Student day, and family interviews must be complete by May 1. Decisions will be sent no later than May 12. 	 April 12 - May 23 All checklist items, including testing, Shadow Student day, and family interviews must be completed within 2 weeks of application submission. Decisions will be sent on a rolling basis.

Please note:

- <u>Siblings of currently-enrolled students</u> should apply during the Priority Decision timeframe. Siblings are not guaranteed admittance, but qualified siblings in good standing will receive priority consideration once all steps of the application process have been completed.
- <u>Application decisions</u> will include either an offer of acceptance, a notification of an applicant's placement in our waiting pool, or a decision to decline the applicant a seat for the upcoming school year.
- If a grade level is full, qualified applicants will be placed in a <u>wait pool</u>. When a spot becomes available in that grade, all applicants in the wait pool will be reviewed for admission.

*Prospective Parent Meetings are required for families applying to Pre-K through 6th Grade.

Admissions Testing	 Admissions testing varies by grade level of the applicant: Pre-K applicants: no testing is required. Kindergarten applicants: participate in on-campus Kinder Readiness assessments in the spring. 1st grade and above: participate in on-campus ACS assessments including writing, grammar, and math. Note: if your student has recent ISEE test scores, those can be uploaded to the online application. 		
Shadow Student Day	We require students applying to 5th grade and above to spend a day on campus as a Shadow Student. These dates vary and can be scheduled with our Admissions department.		
Family Interview	 The Family Interview takes place on campus and lasts between 45-60 minutes. Both parents, as well as all applying students are required to attend. Non-applying siblings are welcome to attend, but are not required. <i>Note: all application components, checklist items, and admissions testing is required to be completed before the Family Interview.</i> 		

Admissions Decisions

Admissions Decisions are made by the ACS Admissions Committee, which holistically reviews all applicants during each admissions round. Decisions will be communicated in writing, and enrollment forms as well as the registration fee must be submitted no later than ten days after notice of acceptance. If extended an offer, your student's spot will be held for ten business days.

Preparing for School

The preparation process includes purchasing uniforms, as well as certain curriculum items depending on your grade level. Additional items to note:

- There is a one time new family fee of \$500 for families enrolling in Kindergarten or above.
- Families with incoming students in 5th grade and above are required to attend our Readiness Academy, July 23-25, 2025.
- All families are required to participate in our Co-Teacher Training during the week of August 5, 2025. *Note: Families that only have Pre-K students are only required to attend 1-2 sessions during that week.*
